## **Where to put the A4 poster (best in colour if you can!):**

- ▼ Your local dog off leash park notice boards
  - ✓ TIP: put together 20 or so half page flyers; hole punch a hole, then use a plastic garden tie to fix to somewhere where people can tear them off
- ▼ Your vet, doctor's, chiropractor's etc notice boards (ask first!)
- ▼ Your local Dog Training Club (often have a notice board and they'll often hand out your flyers for you)
- ▼ Your local Shopping Centre Notice Boards
- ▼ Any Community Notice Boards and High Street Notice Boards
- ▼ Club notice boards
- ▼ Dog and cat grooming parlours and mobile washes leave a poster and a stack of ¼ page flyers for them to hand out to customers
- ▼ Fish and Chip, MacDonald's etc notice boards
- ▼ Office and work-place canteens and kitchens
- ▼ Write to the Animal Companion Animal Officer at your local Council and ask them to put the poster on their notice boards
- ▼ Coffee shops with magazines and newspapers that clientele read
- ▼ Local markets and of course your local Doggie Day Out – find a sympathetic stall holder who will display and hand out flyers for you

## **Where to distribute the smaller 1/2 A4 or 1/4 A4 sheets**

**Print off and keep a stack with you when you are out walking**

- Give one to every dog owner you meet walking! (you can say – *“there is a petition to sign– please help”* or *“as an animal lover, there is information for you about the reasons and what you can do about the awful pound euthanasia problem – did you know that we kill 2500,000 healthy cats and dogs a year?”*)
- Please don't be embarrassed about giving these out on your walks – most dog lovers will appreciate the information! You don't have to do a lot every time – just 2 or 3 on each dog walk will simply add up to thousands if we all do this!
- If you see a cat in a front garden – drop one into the letter box!
- Do a letter box drop with the smaller 1/2 or 1/4 size: set yourself a target of 10 houses a day for one month – that's 300 households who will get the message
- Drop off a stack in places where people can pick them up eg at a friendly person's stall at markets etc
- If you feel bold you can hand out to people coming out of pet shops, although you are not meant to hand out leaflets in shopping centres. The worst they can do is ask you to stop or leave
- Another good place is in the boxes at parks that Councils leave for dog poo bags – unroll a dozen and slip them into the roll every couple of bags
