5 Also, you say "*Regulation only works on those who choose to be regulated*". What evidence do you have to support this statement? (RTA might be interested to see this by the way).

6 Your letter says that you will be "happy to provide more information, "based on science"". Could you advise please what specifically might be that science that you refer to? (fyi, I have a Masters Degree in a science and I can honestly say that I haven't seen any 'science' so far in anything any of the objectors to the Bill have produced)

7 You will be aware that a number of groups are calling for a full independent enquiry into the NSW pet industry to be carried out under the Upper House of the NSW parliament. As there seems to be a lot of disputable assertions in this whole debate, a full and open enquiry, under oath will reveal all the facts that Ministers will need to decide upon future animal welfare legislation or otherwise.

Groups or people who have nothing to fear from such an enquiry will support it wholeheartedly.
